



Construction of upgrades and improvements to South Island Beach Interceptor (CI-1A) and South Island Interceptor (SI-11), in Berkeley Township, the Boroughs of Seaside Park and Seaside Heights, Long Beach Township and the Borough of Beach Haven, at a capital cost of \$3,000,000 were financed by the New Jersey Environmental Infrastructure Financing Program (NJEIFP). The NJEIFP is a State Revolving Fund program jointly administered by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) and the New Jersey Environmental Infrastructure Trust (Trust) and uses a combination of funds provided by the United States Environmental Protection Agency, the DEP, and the Trust to provide very low interest loans to borrowers for environmental infrastructure projects.

This project will provide water quality benefits and improve the reliability of the systems that convey wastewater for residents and businesses in the Central Service Area and Southern Service Area of Ocean County.

State Revolving Fund programs around the nation provide states and communities the resources necessary to maintain and improve the infrastructure protecting our valuable water resources nationwide.
